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RE: Dave Rehnberg


To whom it may concern:

It is with great pleasure that I write this letter of recommendation for Dave, but first I feel it will be beneficial to include a little information about myself. I have been involved with Christian Education for about 32 years. Most of that time was at a pre-school through grade 12 school in the California Central San Joaquin Valley that had an average attendance of about 275 during the time I was there. Although I taught continuously, I was also the high school principal for 15 years and the Chief Administrator for a for 5 years.
